

Call for Expression of Interest for the Design of Infographic

The African Centre for Leadership, Strategy and Development (Centre LSD) with the support of the Open Society Initiative for West Africa (OSIWA), is implementing a project titled **Strengthening Civic Engagement and Advocacy for Effective Natural Resource Governance in Nigeria II**. The project focused on changing the narrative in the governance of natural resources in Nigeria is implemented in Ebonyi (Okposi, Umuoghara Ezza LGA), Ekiti (Ijero in Ijero LGA) and Taraba (Gashaka in Gashaka LGA).

To have greater depth of the issues in the mineral sector, Centre LSD commissioned a research "Policy Research on Solid Mineral Development in Nigeria: Evidence from Ebonyi, Ekiti and Taraba States", which was finalized late last year, with report submitted to the Centre.

Further to the project deliverable, the Centre seeks Expression of Interest (EOI) from qualified Consultant(s) to turn the report of the study into infographics that would be used to engage stakeholders.

Expected Deliverables:

The Consultant(s) is/are expected to deliver on the following:

In the short term:

- 1. Read through the research report and generate ideas for the infographics.
- 2. Share the draft of the ideas from the readings with Centre LSD team

In the medium term:

- 3. Design the infographics based on shared consensus.
- 4. Share the draft of the work with the Centre's team for input and feedback.

In the long term:

5. Produce and submit a final publishable version in soft copy.

Timelines for Completion

The timeline for development and submission of infographics will be a maximum of twenty days (20 days) effective from the date the contract was signed.

Eligibility Criteria

Applications should include:

- \cdot Capability statement showing evidence of previous works done, including links to such works where possible.
- · Evidence of registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC)
- · Corporate Bank Account details alongside Tax Identification Number (TIN)
